PURPOSE SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to:

- inform the community of progress made in delivering the Frome Street Bikeway, and
- provide an initial summary of the consultation responses.

SECTION 1: GLEN OSMOND ROAD TO CARRINGTON STREET

At its 29 January 2013 meeting, Council resolved to proceed to the detailed design and construction of the Frome Street Bikeway section from Glen Osmond Road to Carrington Street.

Prior to construction, a third stage of community engagement was undertaken to inform the community of the changes made to the design since the previous consultation in October / November 2012 and to show in greater detail what will be constructed.

The third stage consultation closed on 15 August and a summary of the response is provided below.

SECTION 2: CARRINGTON STREET TO PIRIE STREET

At its 6 August 2013 meeting, Council also resolved to proceed to the detailed design and construction of the Frome Street Bikeway section from Carrington Street to Pirie Street, with the inclusion of additional street trees.

Prior to construction, a third stage of community engagement was undertaken to inform the community of the changes made to the design since the previous consultation in October / November 2012 and to show in greater detail what will be constructed.

The third stage consultation closed on 4 October 2013, and a brief summary of the response is provided below.

SECTION 3: PIRIE STREET TO NORTH TERRACE

A series of pre-consultation meetings have been held with key stakeholders, including The Culshaw Group of Companies and Mantra on Frome, to better understand their operations and how the Bikeway will affect them. As a result of these meetings the concept designs will be refined to resolve the following issues:

- Hotel pick-up / drop-off areas
 - Shared area and concern with conflicts between embarking and disembarking passengers with cyclists. Reduction measures such as use of lines, signs, pedestrian channelling and guidance lighting will be explored.
 - Luggage loading / unloading, including positioning of hotel baggage trolleys.
 - MFS and SAAS vehicle positioning when attending to an emergency call.
 - SeaLink Kangaroo Island coach loading / unloading at the hotels.
 - Improve current loading arrangements for large delivery trucks.
- Wilsons and UPark car park access via right turn from Frome Street.
- Parking provision for people with disabilities.

The refined concepts will be presented to key stakeholders for their feedback prior to full community engagement.

Due to the need to amend the concept designs, the Christmas / holiday period consultation curfew, four consultations for other bike projects taking place in November (refer to list below) and staff resourcing, the broader community engagement has been rescheduled to February 2014.
