PROJECT INFORMATION

City of Adelaide has received an application from the Returned and Services League (RSL) of Australia (SA Branch) Inc to hold the ANZAC Day Dawn Service and ANZAC Day Commemorative March on roads within the City of Adelaide on Saturday 25 April 2020.

To facilitate this activity, it is proposed that the below roads will be closed, as per the below schedule:

To facilitate the road closure, it is proposed that all the on-street parking spaces on the closed section of the roads will be changed to 'No stopping – Tow-Away' for the duration of the road closure. Pedestrian access will be maintained along the closed roads and the event site will not be fenced.

Under the *Local Government Act 1999*, public consultation is required for events which propose to alter the purpose of a road, by using a public road for business purposes.

Frequently Asked Questions

ANZAC Day Dawn Service

The Dawn Service is a tradition on ANZAC Day across Australia in country and metropolitan areas across Australia and New Zealand.

The Adelaide Dawn Service is held at the South Australian National War Memorial on the corner of Kintore Avenue and North Terrace commencing at 6.00am.

ANZAC Day Commemorative March

The ANZAC Day March traditionally commences at 9.30am from North Terrace, Adelaide, from the SA National War Memorial, and turns right onto King William Road. The march concludes at the Cross of Sacrifice in Pennington Gardens, North Adelaide. Spectators are invited to line both North Terrace and King William Road (between North Terrace and the Adelaide Bridge). It is important to note that the ANZAC Day March in Adelaide is a commemorative march and not a parade. Statement of the principles of the Adelaide ANZAC Day March includes information for descendants of deceased former members of Australian, New Zealand and allied/coalition forces. Veterans, ex-service personnel, allies and Australian Defence Force units participate in the ANZAC Day March. The event is televised live on ABC Television.

How will stakeholders be notified of this event?

Residents and businesses residing in the areas impacted by the road closures will be notified of the upcoming event via a letterbox drop organised by the event organiser two weeks prior the event. Included in the letter will be details of expected noise and road closure details.

Would businesses remain accessible during the ANZAC Day Dawn Service and ANZAC Day Commemorative March.

Yes, while the road will be closed to vehicular traffic, pedestrians will still be able to access the businesses on and the event organisers will ensure the footpaths are kept clear to provide clear access to existing premises.

Will commercial vehicles be able to service businesses within the road closures? During the road closure no vehicles (authorised vehicles will be exempt) will be able to access the closed portion of road.
